Infrastructure Capital Improvements Plan

- 1. Drainage Improvements drainage improvements, property acquisition and street improvements as required for the areas of McKee St., Steyskal St (by Union Hall), S. Foy Street (dip in back of Iniguez).
- Street Improvements Street and drainage improvements including property acquisition for N.Foy St., Rosemary/North/Walnut Street area. \$40,000 currently from NMDOT.
- 3. HWY 356 Sidewalks keep this until we have secured all funding (in case we need additional funds). \$628,130 currently from NMDOT.
- 4. Recreation Improvements continue seeking funds to improve recreation areas including concession stand at little league. Approximately \$280,000 available.
- 5. Library Improvements continue to seek improvements to correct water damage on interior wall. Source of water entry has not been determined.
- 6. Heavy Equipment funding for heavy equipment for the maintenance department.
- 7. Depot Improvements seek funding to improve the buildings.
- 8. Wastewater Improvements seek funding to continue with improvements.
- Library Extension Outdoor seek funding to create an outdoor library/activity area.
- 10. Cemetery Fencing funding to install wrought iron fencing.
- 11. Wastewater Solar Project seek funding to create solar array at facility.
- 12. Water System Improvements funding for system improvements (requires a PER). Funding for 2 PRV stations on N Main with traffic bearing vaults.
- 13. Sewer System Improvements funding for system improvements (requires a PER). Oak Street lift station modernization and automation, Lusk Street Sewer reroute, sewer main line in Whitewater Creek.
- 14. ADA Improvements funding to create ADA improvements at street intersections.
- 15. Community Center Improvements funding for improvements for storage, roof, flooring, ventilation.

- 16. City Hall Improvements combining old fire station and city hall.
- 17. Police Department Building new roof.
- 18. Hurley Street Lights and sidewalks construct sidewalks along Hurley Ave and install additional street lighting.
- 19. Fire Department Building seek funds for new fire department and land. (Department has outgrown available space dedicated to fire).
- 20. Street Lighting on HWY 180/356 replace/upgrade lighting on Hwy 180 and/or Hwy 356 to include auxiliary power for Christmas lights. \$600,000 currently from NMDOT
- 21. Water Tank Rehabilitation Water tank rehab (1 million gallon), lead abatement, repaint, install new valves.
- 22. Public Safety Equipment Vehicles and equipment for fire and police departments.
- 23. Union Hall Improvements seek funding to improve the buildings.
